3. Resolution to appoint Ralph Rowland to the Skagit County Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. His term shall commence on April 15, 2013, and continue until December 31, 2015.

5. Amendment No. 2 to Contract No. C20050250 with HART Intercivic. This Amendment provides extended hardware warranties on the DAU, JBC and VBO election equipment through June 13, 2014. Compensation is increased by \$567.00, for a new contract amount not to exceed \$253,871.86. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and subsequent Amendments shall remain in effect.

c) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

6. Vendor Services Agreement with Great Floors Commercial Sales to install moisture barrier sealer and replace carpet in Skagit County Records Office, located at 1800 Continental Place in Mount Vernon. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and shall continue for one year. Compensation shall not exceed \$10,522.26, including applicable sales tax.

d) INFORMATION SERVICES:

7. Subscription Services Agreement with InTime Services Inc. to provide scheduling software for the Skagit County Sheriff and will replace the current Speedshift application currently installed which will no longer be supported in 2014. The Agreement with InTime Services Inc. will commence on the date of execution and continue for three years. Compensation shall not exceed \$35,040.
8. Personal Services Agreement with Handel Information Technologies, Inc. to assess the current sanctions process utilized by the Office of Juvenile Courts and determine the best methodology to improve workflow. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2013. Compensation shall not exceed \$540.

f) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES:

10. Amendment A to Contract No. F12-52205-004, Skagit County Interlocal Agreement No. C20120491, with Washington State Department of Commerce, State Energy Office, to develop a land use ordinance to enable and regulate small and mid-sized wind power projects. This Amendment revises the end date to June 30, 2013 to correspond to the US Department of Energy Windpowering America grant. Compensation remains the same and will not exceed \$12,500.
11. Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement with Donald and Carmen Krieger for Parcel No. P69569 in the amount of \$122,000. This purchase is the second property which is part of the Mitigation Project Grant Agreement No. E11-133, Skagit County Contract No. C20110071, with the Washington State Military Department and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to provide funds to acquire and demolish two flood-prone structures located in the floodplain of the Skagit River and its tributaries.
12. Easement with Skagitwilde Corporation for Parcel Numbers P119533 and P69569. This Easement is part of the Mitigation Project Grant Agreement No. E11-133, Skagit County Contract No. C20110071, with the Washington State Military Department and the Federal Emergency

Management Agency (FEMA) to provide funds to acquire and demolish two flood-prone structures located in the floodplain of the Skagit River and its tributaries.

Work Plan/Financial Plan with the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Services- Wildlife Services (APHIS-WS), in accordance with Cooperative Services Agreement No. 12-73-53-2009-RA, Skagit County Agreement No. C20100567, to provide assistance to Skagit County for wildlife control activities. The Agreement shall commence on June 1, 2013, and continue through June 30, 2014. Compensation shall not exceed \$6,845.

i) RISK MANAGEMENT:

19. Personal Services Agreement with Rose Environmental to conduct air quality sampling for employee hazard assessment aboard the Guemes Ferry. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2013. Compensation shall not exceed \$10,000.

20. The road department determined that it was necessary to purchase road maintenance materials prior to the execution of the contract to avoid delays in the maintenance of County roads.

So that maintenance on County roads was not delayed, materials were purchased from the Contractor before the final execution of the Agreement, making it necessary to correct the term.

Amendment No. 1 to Vendor Services Agreement No. C20130115 with Martin Marietta Materials to provide gravel and rock products as listed in Attachment “A” of the 2013 spring/summer Material Eligibility List.
