3. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20130320 with DLR Group to determine the requirements for expansion of the existing County Jail facility, as well as provide cost estimates and capital and operational costs for the renovation/expansion of the existing County Jail facility and compare those costs to a new facility of comparable scope. This Amendment increases compensation by \$5,000 for an additional two renderings, one for each potential jail site. The original Agreement commenced on January 1, 2013, and the term remains the same, ending December 31, 2014. Compensation shall not exceed \$60,005. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

The Agreement shall commence on January 1, 2014, and continue until December 31, 2014. Compensation shall not exceed \$25,000.
9. Personal Services Agreement with The Language Exchange, Inc. to provide interpretation and translation (spoken and/or written) services for Community Services. The Agreement shall commence on January 1, 2014, and continue until December 31, 2014. Compensation shall not exceed \$7,500.
10. Personal Services Agreement with Sharon M. Robinson Holmes to provide performance reviews of sub-contract agencies in the program areas of Substance Abuse/Chemical Dependency and Developmental Disabilities utilizing monitoring and evaluation tools approved by Community Services. The Agreement shall commence on January 1, 2014, and continue until December 31, 2014. Compensation shall not exceed \$10,000.

e) EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT:

11. Amendment A to Snohomish County Grant Agreement No. E12-186 (Skagit County Contract No. C20120151) to provide U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) FFY 2011 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) funds to enhance the ability of state, local, and tribal governments to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from terrorist attacks and other disasters. This Amendment increases compensation by \$4,972 for interoperable equipment, extends the term by thirty days to end June 30, 2014, and replaces Exhibit C Budget Sheet to reflect changes to the increased compensation. Compensation to Skagit County shall not exceed \$97,936. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

f) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

12. Amendment No. 1 to Vendor Services Agreement No. C20110513 with Electric West, Inc. to provide electrical services, including the troubleshooting, repair and replacement of electrical components that include, but may not be limited to: power resources, lighting switches and relays; electrical motors; generators, and building lights and electrical infrastructure in general at any and all Skagit County facilities. The Amendment increases compensation by \$4,500. The term remains the same, ending November 20, 2014. Compensation shall not exceed \$14,000. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
13. Amendment No. 3 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20090042 with Graham-Bunting Associates to provide the complete 10-year monitoring for wetland mitigation associated with the Skagit County Commissioners' Administrative Building, located at 1800 Continental Place. This Amendment increases compensation by \$3,500 for a new total amount not to exceed \$22,300 in order to pay for additional services provided and outlined in task seven: working with the City of Mount Vernon to remove hazardous trees near Kulshan Creek. The term of the Agreement remains the same, ending December 31, 2018. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and subsequent Amendments shall remain in effect.

g) INFORMATION SERVICES:

14. Business Class Service Order Agreement with Comcast to provide internet, TV, and phone service to 116 South 11<sup>th</sup> Street in Mount Vernon, the new location for the County Coroner. This Contract will supersede Skagit County Contract No. C20130422 which was signed on October 17, 2013, as this contract will bundle all three services together. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until October 17, 2016. Compensation shall not exceed \$5,927.40.
15. Resolution authorizing the sole source procurement for Spillman Technology Public Safety System Software upgrade to purchase additional Hiplink and mobile licenses.
16. Addendum No. 13 to Contract No. 00484 with Spillman Technologies, Inc. authorizing the procurement of the Spillman HipLink Interface to support Skagit 911 with alphanumeric paging capability. The HipLink interface was part of the bulk purchase negotiation done with Spillman Technologies. The original Agreement commenced on July 31, 1989, and shall continue indefinitely. This Amendment increases compensation by \$36,848 for a new compensation amount not to exceed \$805,311 for the procurement of an additional 750 Hiplink receiver licenses, 1 additional fire mobile license, and training for jail staff on the new Spillman Syntryx software that will be implemented in 2014. Skagit County will be reimbursed \$18,454 from Skagit 911. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and subsequent Amendments shall remain in effect.

h) PARKS AND RECREATION:

17. Amendment No. 1 to Funding Agreement No. C20120423 with Skagit Land Trust for the purpose of providing funding for the acquisition and permanent protection of lands in Skagit County that will contribute to a corridor for Skagit County's planned Centennial Trail. This Amendment extends the term for one year, ending December 31, 2014. Compensation remains the same and shall not exceed \$50,000. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
18. Amendment No. 3 to Funding Agreement No. C20100594 with Skagit Land Trust to provide reimbursement for securing public trail access and protecting an open corridor on South Fidalgo Island from Donnell Road to Deception Pass State Park. The purpose of this Amendment is to extend the expiration date of the Funding Agreement from December 31, 2013, to December 31, 2014. Compensation remains the same and shall not exceed \$150,000. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until September 30, 2014. Compensation shall not exceed \$26,000 and is reimbursable by the DOE Grant Agreement.
