## AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

They will consider, review and recommend priority projects for affordable and low-income housing developments; encourage and coordinate local affordable housing development activities; work with partner agencies to help locate and secure funding opportunities for sustainable coordinated housing efforts; evaluate and address a variety of community housing needs; evaluate population projections and inventory data to prioritize recommendations, and provide a forum for the community on affordable housing. The Committee shall present their findings and recommendations at an annual public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners. The Committee was established by Skagit County Resolution No. R20100206, dated July 6, 2010.

## Boundary Review Board

**Purpose:** The Washington State Boundary Review Board for Skagit County was established in accordance with state statutes to provide local independent review of certain actions proposed by cities, towns and special purpose districts. The actions that most commonly come before the Board are annexations. The Washington State Legislature has specifically defined the purpose, authority, makeup, terms, fees and procedures of Boundary Review Boards. This legislation and amendments that have occurred over the years are contained in Chapter 36.93, Revised Code of Washington (RCW).

The Boundary Review Board offers affected jurisdictions and citizens the only independent review of proposed boundary changes. Its jurisdiction is invoked only when there is a dispute regarding a proposed action. Its decisions are based on specific statutory objectives and consistency with the Growth Management Act, and its written hearing decisions reflect those statutory requirements.
