**WHAT :** Advanced OTEP #2 will cover shock, pharmacology, medical/legal issues and pulse oximetry monitoring



**2014 NREMT Pass Rates**

The State DOH just sent each County their first time and cumulative pass rates for the NREMT exam that all new EMTs take at the end of their initial training. The EMS office's 92% first time and 96% cumulative rates rank us 8<sup>th</sup> in the state (out of 45 programs, as well ahead of the national averages.
