

How To View This Map On An Android Or Apple Mobile Device


To begin, you must first install the "ArcGIS" (created by ESRI, Inc.) application on your mobile device. It can be found in "Google Play" on an Android device, or in the "App Store!" on an Apple device. Your mobile device must meet the minimum requirements of the application for it to work correctly. The ArcGIS application was created by ESRI, Inc. and Skagit County does not provide support for this product. The following examples show how to operate ArcGIS once it's installed on your mobile device. These examples show the iPad application but the Android devices work similarly.

1. Open the ArcGIS application on your device and select the "Search" button

2. Enter "skagit county" in the "Search" box and then pick search.

3. Select the map you want to open



Tips For Using ArcGIS

Question: How do I locate myself on the map?

Answer: You can locate yourself on the map by using the "Locate" button (lower right corner on an iPad). Note, this activates your devices GPS to locate you.



Question: How do I view information (owner, sales date, property value, etc.) about a parcel?

Answer: Open the Skagit County Property Information Map. Once it's open, zoom in to the parcel of interest and pick the parcel number "point" and a pop-up box will appear. You must pick the parcel number "point" and not the parcel number to get the pop-up box to appear. Once the pop-up appears, pick the Assessor Information link and the Assessor web page for that parcel will appear.
