FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

Request: To include approximately 9.7 acres in the Current Use Timber Program.

Location: Portion of Lot 1, Short Plat #95-008. East of SR 9, west of Lake Cavanaugh Road.

Assessor's No: P18092 (portion)

Public Hearing: After reviewing the report of the Assessor's Office, the Hearing Examiner conducted a public hearing on June 13, 2007.

Recommendation: Approval

FINDINGS

1. Ruth Thomas has filed an application for inclusion of approximately 9.7 acres in the Current Use Timber Program. She is the owner of the property.

2. The property consists of 10.7 acres located east of SR 9 and west of Lake Cavanaugh Road. It is a portion of Lot 1 of Short Plat #95-008 in Sec. 17, T33N, R5E, W.M. The property is a portion of Assessor's Account Number P18092. Approximately one acre is excluded from the application for homesite purposes.

3. The request is to transfer the 9.7 acres from the Open Space Farm and Agriculture classification to Open Space Timber. The homesite will be withdrawn from Open Space Farm and Agriculture.

4. There is a single stand of timber consisting of immature native hardwood with scattered native conifers. The age of the trees ranges from 20 to 50 years. The main species is Red Alder. The owner's goal is to maintain the stand as habitat for the next few years, considering harvest in two unit in 2030 and 2040. Following harvest, reforestation will occur, involving the planting of Western Red Cedar and other conifers and the natural reseeding of Red Alder.

5. A Forest Management Plan was prepared by David Anderson, Forestry Consultant. The plan appears to comply with RCW 84.34.020 and RCW 84.34.041.

6. The Staff Report and Exhibits submitted by the Assessor's Office are incorporated herein.

7. The hearing was held after due notice. The applicant was present and concurred with the Staff recommendation. There was no public testimony and there were no written comments.


8. The Examiner finds that the property meets the definition of the classification sought.

9. The Staff recommends approval. The Examiner concurs with Staff.

RECOMMENDATION

The Examiner recommends approval of the application, subject to the following condition:

At the time of harvesting, the applicant shall comply with the requirements of the Department of Natural Resources in regard to the harvesting of timber.
