June Kite timely filed a Request for Reconsideration of the Hearing Examiner's decision on remand, issued January 2, 2009, regarding the subject Special Use Permit application.


The Request asserts errors of fact and law and asks for re-evaluation of specified items. It asks that no approval be given until all local requirements are met and other needed State and local approvals are obtained.

The Examiner points out that the approval given in the decision is conditioned on a demonstration of full compliance with all requirements (State and local) for the proposed water use and the proposed septic system. No building permit may be issued until such compliance is shown.

After review of the Request, the Examiner concludes that no material legal error has occurred, that no material factual issue was erroneously made, and that no issue was overlooked that would change the previous decision.

Therefore, pursuant to RCW 14.06.180, the Request for Reconsideration is denied.
