- All play will utilize Rally Scoring.
- Let Serve** – A ball that when served, hits the net and continues into the opponent's court. The Let Serve is a playable LIVE BALL!
- LIBERO** – There will be NO utilization of the LIBERO player.
- Pool Play** will be one game to 25 points. Teams must win by two or more points or the first team to 30 points. Game times are tentative. All teams are expected to be ready to play five (5) minutes after the completion of the previous game/match. The tournament may also run ahead of schedule.
- SEEDING & TIEBREAKERS:** There are four criteria that will be used.
 - Pool play record
 - Head to head
 - Total points allowed during Pool Play (all four games)
 - Coin Flip (as a last resort)
- Championship Play begins at 1:45 PM.** Check team seed for game times and court location.
- All teams will qualify for the Championship Double Elimination Round. Teams will be seeded by pool play record, head to head competition, and total points allowed. A coin flip will be used as a last resort to break a tie.
- Double Elimination will consist of single games to 25 points (Teams must win by two or more points or the first team to 30 points), except for semifinal and championship rounds where matches will be played using the best 2 out of 3 games (the first two games will be to 25 points, with the third game, if necessary, to be to 15. All semifinal and championship matches will be played straight up with no 2-point margin of victory in effect).
- National Federation of High School Association rules shall govern all tournament play.
- Teams normally consist of 3 male and 3 female players. At no time should more male players be on the court than female players. A team may play with a minimum of 4 players to avoid a forfeit, with no more than two being male
- When it is your team's turn to referee, you are expected to supply:
 - Up Ref
 - Down Ref
 - Scorekeeper
 - Line Judges

Court Key:
East Court
West Court

When teams are eliminated from the tournament, they must stay and referee the next game. Teams that have a bye in the first round of Championship play must referee the first round games.
