Notice is hereby given that on June 22, 2015, Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company filed an application for a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit for a clean products upgrade (CPU). That portion of the CPU within shorelines jurisdiction includes installing a new marine vapor emissions control (MVEC) system with a dock safety unit and a 3 inch diameter natural gas line that will reduce emissions of volatile organic compounds. The MVEC system will control hydrocarbon emissions from marine vessels during loading operations. Those portions of the CPU outside shoreline jurisdiction and within the developed areas of the refinery includes construction of a aromatics recovery unit, expansion of the naptha hydrotreater to reduce sulfur content in gasoline, installing a new Isomerization unit to increase the amount of octane available to the refinery and installing three additional storage tanks. The proposed project is located within the Anacortes Urban Development District (A-UD) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area.

The subject site is located at 10200 West March Point Road, within Sections 21, 28 & 29 Township 35 North, Range 2 East, Skagit County, WA (Parcels *P32990 & P32989*).

A completed application, SEPA check list, site plan and all pertinent information are on file at Skagit County Planning & Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was deemed complete, which was July 6, 2015 unless such time period is extended consistent with RCW 36.70B.090. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is required for this project.
