Firms performing renovation, repair, and painting projects in Washington State that disturb lead-based paint in pre-1978 homes, child care facilities and schools must be certified and must follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination. Property owners who perform these projects in pre-1978 rental housing or space rented by child-care facilities must be certified and must follow the lead-safe work practices required by the Renovation, Repair and Painting rule (RRP).

Who should apply?

Firms applying for Washington State RRP certification for the first time.
Firms wishing to renew their certification for RRP.
