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Public Notice Required

Skagit County Code makes public notice and comment an integral part of many land use applications. You have been given a public notice as part of your land use application. You are responsible for posting this notice consistent with legal requirements. Failure to do so may invalidate the public process and delay the application process. In case of unusual property configuration, PDS may determine the placement and number of signs required.

SCC 14.06.150(2) lists the applications that are exempt from the public notice requirements. All other permits require public notice. A sign permit is not required for these signs.

Posting Requirements

- Post signs and return the certification below within 15 days of application.
- Post signs so that they are easily viewable by the public, including one sign on each street frontage bordering the subject property.
- Install the corrugated plastic sign on the provided metal stake, or by supporting the sign on at least two posts, with the top edge not higher than 7 ft.
- Do not post signs where they may cause a traffic or pedestrian hazard, or where they are obscured by vegetation.
- Do not attach to utility poles or trees.
- Maintain signs on site until the time of final decision, then remove.
- Contact PDS if your sign is lost or destroyed.
