2. Give the partially completed form to the public water system purveyor.

3. Return the completed evaluation form and fee* to the Skagit County Environmental Public Health Division.

4. A satisfactory water system evaluation is required *prior* to submitting for a building permit.

SMALL (GROUP B)

<14 Homes OR <25 People
Building Permit \$350

usually involves a water system inspection

LARGE (GROUP A)

Community System (=15+ homes)
Building Permit \$150
Non-Community System (>25 People)
Building Permit \$350

may involve a water system inspection
