

# SKAGIT COUNTY PLANNING AND PERMIT CENTER NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given that on January 19, 2001 Craig Cammock filed an application for a Variance to allow for the expansion of a damaged preexisting nonconforming building. A letter of completeness was issued on February 16, 2001.

The proposed project is located at 20327 English Road, Mount Vernon, WA: within a portion of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 21, Township 33 North, Range 04 East, W.M., Skagit County, Wa.

This project proposal is being reviewed under the provisions of SCC 14.24, Skagit County Critical Areas Ordinance. For additional information contact the County.

Other permits that may be necessary in the development of the project but not included in the above noted application include: building permit.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.210, a decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date of the letter of completeness which was February 16, 2001. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner has been **tentatively** scheduled for April 25, 2001 in Hearing Room C of the County Administration Building, Mount Vernon, Washington, at the hour of 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter for the purpose of determining whether the Hearing Examiner should approve, modify and approve or deny the application.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Marge Swint, Associate Planner, in writing of his or her interest within fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is March 1, 2001.
