

**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)**

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: This is a non-project proposal to receive Water Quality Program financial assistance. This assistance will be used to implement SCC 14.24.120, Ongoing Agriculture on Agricultural Lands and SCC 14.24.130, Strategic Plan for Protecting Wild Salmonids.

Appeals must be submitted by March 30, 2001.
