

## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Code revision to Skagit County Code Section 12.64 relating to Skagit County Clean Water District Edison Subarea. Proposed code amendments offers three alternatives: Cost of pumping septic tanks borne by the town or individual owner, values of residential ERU set from national or Edison testing baseline results, and operation and maintenance of grease traps. The code sections further describe and define policy, the roles and responsibilities of the subarea, improvements and costs associated with the operation and maintenance of the subarea, rate structure and budget organization, approvals, inspections, easements, construction/installation of components, fees, unlawful use and enforcement. Also included are appendices on definitions, standards, schedules, forms and a service area map. The Edison Clean Water District subarea consists of applicable properties located within Skagit County, Town of Edison, Sections 32 and 33, Township 36 North, Range 3 East and Sections 4 and 5, Township 35 North, Range 3 East.

You may appeal this threshold determination in accordance with Skagit County Code 14.08.110 and then by filing such with the Skagit County Planning and Permit Center for service to the SEPA responsible official within fourteen (14) calendar days after the date of the comment period.

Appeals must be submitted by June 14, 2002.
