Notice is hereby given that on May 2, 2002, Gilbert Loyd filed an Administrative Special Use application for the placement of a temporary mobile home on a parcel of property with an existing residence, for the close medical care of a family member. The application was determined complete on May 15, 2002.

The proposed project is located at 15872 Otter Pond Drive in Mount Vernon; within a portion of Section 24, Township 34 North, Range 4 East W.M., Skagit County, Washington. The parcel is located within a Rural Reserve Zoning/Comprehensive Plan designated area as identified in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps as adopted July 24, 2000.

Other approvals or permits that may be needed for this proposal include, but are not limited to:

- Approved Building Permit
- Approved Septic Permit

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined to be complete, which was May 15, 2001. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Carly Ruacho, Assistant Planner, in writing within fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is May 23, 2002.
