**NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION**

Notice is hereby given that on June 1, 2005, Snohomish County Emergency Radio System, c/o Ron Solemsaas and Eric Sladky, filed a State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist in conjunction with Building permit application #BP05-0543 for the construction/installation of an emergency radio communications facility on Frailey Mountain. The project proposal includes the installation of a prefabricated equipment shelter (approximately 220 square feet) installed on a concrete foundation at grade, a generator, a fuel tank and a 180 foot tall lattice tower to support antennas for the Snohomish County Emergency Radio System. The proposed project is located within an Industrial Forest Natural Resource Lands (IF-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 24, 2000, and as thereafter amended. A letter of completeness was issued and the application was determined to be complete on June 7, 2005.

The project is located at 18627 State Route 530, Arlington, within a portion of Section 35, Township 33N, Range 6 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington.

A completed Building permit application, Environmental Checklist and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. No other governmental approvals or permits will be required for this proposal.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined complete, which was 6-7-05. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or to be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Brandon Black in writing of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is 6-9-05.

Written comments must be received no later than 4:30 pm on: **June 24, 2005**

The Lead Agency expects to issue a DNS for this proposal and the Optional DNS process is being used (WAC 197-141-355). **This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal.**
