Notice is hereby given that on June 20, 2005, the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved Forest Practice Waiver request PL05-0164. On March 21, 2005, Day Creek Sand & Gravel filed the Forest Practice Waiver Application. A six-year development moratorium was in effect through January 25, 2006 as a result of non-conversion Forest Practice Application 2803387. Approval of the waiver will allow the County to proceed with processing application for Special Use (PL05-0094) for expanded mining operations.

The subject property is located at 30623 South Skagit Highway, within a portion of the northeast ¼ of Section 30, Township 35N, Range 6E, W.M., Skagit County, Washington. Skagit County Parcel Numbers: P42076, P42077

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

As provided in SCC 14.06.120, the decision of the Hearing Examiner after the open record hearing shall be final, unless appealed to the Board by filing a written Notice of Appeal with the Planning and Development Services office within 14 days after the date of the Hearing Examiner decision, or decision on reconsideration, if applicable. The appeal fee must accompany the Notice of Appeal, and the Notice of Appeal is not considered filed unless the appeal fee accompanies it.
