**NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION**

Notice is hereby given that on May 17, 2005, Diking District #1, c/o Bob Dean filed a grading permit application #BP05-0581 for the placement of 2,500 cubic yards of material for needed maintenance to the top of the existing levee that runs between Jungquist Road and Calhoun Road. The maintenance work will place, grade, and compact clay fill on top of the existing levee. The proposed project is located within an Agricultural Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 24, 2000, and as thereafter amended. A letter of completeness was not issued and the application was determined to be complete on June 14, 2005.

The project is located on the Levee along Penn Road, between Jungquist Road and Calhoun Road, Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 25, Township 34N, Range 3 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington.

A completed Grading permit application, Environmental Checklist and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. No other governmental approvals or permits will be required for this proposal.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined complete, which was 6-14-05. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or to be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Brandon Black in writing of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is 6-23-05.

Written comments must be received no later than 4:30 pm on: **July 8, 2005**

The Lead Agency expects to issue a DNS for this proposal and the Optional DNS process is being used (WAC 197-141-355). **This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal.**
