Notice is hereby given that on June 28, 2005, the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved Special Use Permit # PL05-0061 submitted by Mary Rose. The permit as conditioned, allows the operation of a medical consulting business in a residence, involving visits to the site by an average of 5 to 7 clients each week. In addition, the applicant will be allowed to operate a small scale dog breeding business in the residence.

The Critical Areas review was completed and it was determined that there were no issues in association with the proposal.

The proposed project is located at 5477 Campbell Lake Road, Anacortes, WA; within a portion of Section 12, Township 34, Range 01, W.M., Skagit County, WA.

The parcel number is 19249 and the property is located in the Rural Reserve zone.

Pursuant to Skagit County Code (SCC) 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Administrative Official to the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to the provisions of SCC 14.06.120. Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to Planning and Development Services within 14 calendar days of the date of decision pursuant to SCC 14.06.120.
