NOTICE OF DECISION

Notice is hereby given that on February 14, 2006, the Board of County Commissioners held a closed record hearing for the appeal (PL05-0916) of the Hearing Examiner's decision approving an Administrative Special Use Permit (PL04-0941) for a Temporary Manufactured Home for Farm Worker Housing. The administrative decision had been appealed (PL05-0427) to the Hearing Examiner; the appeal was denied and the permit was upheld. On February 21, 2006, the Board of County Commissioners denied the appeal (PL05-0916) and approved the permit (PL04-0941). The resolution upholding the Hearing Examiner's decision and denying the appeal (PL05-0916), and approving the permit (PL04-0941) was signed on March 13, 2006.

The property is located at 10566 District Line Road, Burlington, Washington, within a portion of Section 28, Township 35, Range 4 W.M., Skagit County, Washington. The site is accessed via State Route 20 off of District Line Road. The parcel # is P38045.

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Board of County Commissioners to Superior Court pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.220. Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal within 21 days from the date of adoption of the resolution or ordinance.
