Notice is hereby given that on September 21, 2006 Kimberly Johnson filed an application for a Special Use Permit to allow for a "doggie daycare" and the use of the outdoor garden area as a photography location as a Home Based Business 2. A letter of completeness was issued on November 7, 2006.

The proposed project is located at 13913 Avon Allen Road, Mt. Vernon, WA, Skalings Addition to the Town of Avon Lots 2, 3, & 6 Block 13; within a portion of the SW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 12, Township 34 North, Range 03 East, W.M., Skagit County, WA.

A completed application is on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. This project proposal has been reviewed under the provisions of SCC 14.24, Skagit County Critical Areas Ordinance. For additional information contact the County.

Other permits that *may be* necessary in the development of the project but not included in the above noted application include: access permit, fill & grade permit, building permit.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.210 a decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined to be complete which was November 7, 2006. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner will be scheduled in the future for the purpose of determining whether the Hearing Examiner should approve, modify and approve or deny the application.
