Notice is hereby given that on August 2, 2010, Wes and LeeAnn Melton filed a State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist in conjunction with Building permit application #BP10-0409 for the removal of an old wooden bridge across Willard Creek and the construction of a new cement bridge in the same location to access three home sites. The proposed bridge will be fourteen (14") feet wide and twenty (20') feet long. The proposed project is located within the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted October 10, 2007 and as there after amended. A letter of completeness was not issued and the application was determined to be complete on August 31, 2010.

The proposed project is located north of F & S Grade Road at 8629 Copper Lane, Sedro-Woolley, within a portion of Section 14, Township 35N, Range 4 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P36542).

A completed Building Permit, Environmental Checklist, site plan, and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. No other governmental approvals or permits will be required for this proposal from Skagit County Planning and Development Services include.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined complete, which was 8-31-10. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project. Any person desiring to express his or her views or to be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Brandon Black in writing of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is 9-2-10.

Written comments must be received no later than 4:30 pm on: **September 17, 2010**  
*Email correspondence will not be accepted.*

The Lead Agency expects to issue a DNS for this proposal and the Optional DNS process is being used (WAC 197-11-355). **This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal.**
