Notice is hereby given that Skagit Hill Recycling, Inc. (Appellant) filed an Appeal of Notice and Order to Abate to the Hearing Examiner on May 17, 2010.

The appellant appealed a Notice and Order to Abate, dated November 13, 2008, and a Notice and Order to Abate, dated May 5, 2010. The Orders relate to asserted violations at the subject site, including unlawful solid waste handling, building code non-compliance, drainage obstruction, and improper signs. The Notices and Orders to Abate are affirmed in part and reversed in part. The Hearing Examiner rendered his decision on August 23, 2010.

The full file is on record with Skagit County Planning and Development Services (PDS). This information is available to the public on request.

A Request for Reconsideration may be filed with PDS within 10 days of this decision (SCC 14.06.180). The decision may be appealed to the Board of County Commissioners within 14 days of the date of decision or decision on reconsideration, if applicable. (SCC 14.06.110(13)). Standing to bring an appeal shall be limited to aggrieved parties. Parties with standing to appeal must submit the Notice of Appeal application and appeal fees to Planning and Development Services within 14 calendar days of the decision, which was August 23, 2010.
