

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION BY SKAGIT COUNTY OF
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCC 14.32.040, THE DRAINAGE ORDINANCE, FOR
FOREST PRACTICE CONVERSIONS AND CONVERSION OPTION HARVEST
PLANS AND AMENDING SCC 14.04, THE DEFINITIONS OF “DEVELOPMENT”**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on December 30, 2002, the Skagit County Board of Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. O20020011. The effective date of this Ordinance is December 30, 2002. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend both Skagit County Code (SCC) 14.32.040, the Drainage Ordinance, specifically for forest practice conversions and conversion option harvest plans and SCC 14.04, the definition of “development.”

The Ordinance shall apply to all lands and to all land use and development and to all structures and facilities in Skagit County except incorporated areas, federal lands, tribal and trust lands unless exempted under the provisions of the Ordinance. The Ordinance shall apply to every person, individual, firm, partnership, corporation, governmental agency or other entity which owns, leases or administers land within Skagit County.

Pursuant to RCW 36.70A.290, all petitions to the Growth Management Hearings Board shall be filed within sixty (60) days after this publication.
