Notice is hereby given that on January 8, 2003, Skagit County approved Administrative Special Use Request PL#01-0727 submitted by Victor and Linda Benson to allow for a temporary outdoor event (Corn Maze) on properties zoned Agriculture-NRL. The event will be held annually from the second week of August through September. The application was deemed complete as of August 30, 2002 and Notice of Development published and posted on September 12, 2002. The Critical Areas review was completed for the project.

The proposed project will be located at either 19020 E. Johnson Road, Mount Vernon, WA; the NW ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 17, Township 33, Range 04 E. W.M. Skagit County, WA; or at 19653 Cedardale Road, Mount Vernon; NW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 08, Township 33, Range 04 E. W.M. Skagit County, WA

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Administrative Official to the Skagit County Hearing Examiner pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.110(7). Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to the Planning and Permit Center within 14 calendar days of the publication of this Notice pursuant to SCC 14.06.110.
