

MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE ADDENDUM

Project Description: State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) review on Forest Practice Application # PL02-0724. This addendum modifies the previously issued Mitigated Determination of Nonsignificance of December 24, 2002. Based on information received during the comment period which categorized wetlands and associated buffers on the subject site, number 5) of the MDNS condition has been corrected to the following: No harvest shall occur within 50 feet of streams or wetlands.

Proponent: Mr. G. Charles Seyler, 11426 18th Place SE, Everett, WA 98205

Project Location: The approximately 46-acre parcel is located south and east of the terminus of Lee Road east of Highway 9 near Big Lake, Skagit County, WA. The parcel is located in the northwest quarter of section 6, Township 33 North, Range 5 East, W.M., Skagit County, Washington. Parcel #s P74581, P74584, P74585, P74582, P74599, P74600, P74601, P74603, P74605 & P74606.

Lead Agency: Skagit County Planning and Permit Center.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(C). This addendum adds information about the proposal but does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts or alternatives in the existing environmental document. This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request. This determination is subject to the mitigated measures as identified in the original threshold determination and shall be deemed conditions of approval of the land use and/or permit pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.12. Such conditions are considered binding and may not be altered by subsequent decisions unless a threshold determination is re-issued.

Since an addendum does not contain "significant" new information, a comment period is not required.

There is no administrative appeal of a final environmental threshold determination. All appeals shall be commenced pursuant to the provisions of RCW 43.21C and WAC 197-11.
