NOTICE OF DECISION**

Notice is hereby given that on October 16, 2003, Skagit County approved **PL03-0379** an Administrative Decision Application submitted by **Carmen Ugalde**. The applicant's submitted an Administrative Special Use request pursuant to Skagit County Code (SCC) 14.16.320(3) for the placement of a temporary manufactured home to allow for the close medical care of a family member on a parcel of property with an existing residence. The manufactured home shall remain on the property only for such time that it is needed for the purpose of providing necessary medical care for Steven Taylor. At such time the applicant no longer requires care or resides in the mobile, the manufactured home shall be removed from the property. The proposal is located at 21798 Grip Road; within a portion of Section 3, Township 35 North, Range 4 East W.M., Skagit County, Washington.

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Administrative Official to the Skagit County Hearing Examiner pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.110(7). Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to the Planning and Permit Center within 14 calendar days of the date the decision was issued pursuant to SCC 14.06.110.
