<b>Project Description:</b>	This project will install energy efficient LED signal warning flashers to notify drivers that the westbound signal is changing. As part of this project, we will also upgrade the signal cabinet and other related hardware.
<b>Status:</b>	In Design
<b>Traffic Impacts:</b>	Traffic impacts should be minimal during construction of the project. It is anticipated that there will not be any lane closures during construction, but there could be minimal delays during the installation of new equipment.
