SKAGIT COUNTY PROPOSITION NO. 1 SALES AND USE TAX FOR EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS AND FACILITIES

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. R20030054 concerning a sales/use tax for emergency communications systems and facilities. This proposition authorizes a sales tax at the rate of one-tenth of one percent, and use tax in the amount of the value of the article used consistent with RCW 82.14, to be used solely for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency Communication Systems and Facilities, including costs associated with financing, designing, acquiring, constructing, equipping, operating, maintaining, remodeling, repairing, re-equipping and improving of these emergency communication systems and facilities.

SKAGIT COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO. 6 PROPOSITION NO. 1 GENERAL OBLIGATION FIRE SAFETY BONDS - \$1,950,000

The Board of Commissioners of Skagit County Fire District No. 6 adopted Resolution No. 3-03 concerning improvement bonds. This proposition authorizes Skagit County Fire District No. 6 to acquire, construct and equip two new fire stations, to issue \$1,950,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years to finance such improvements, and to levy property taxes annually in excess of regular property tax levies to repay such bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 3-03 .
