Next, place the secrecy envelope into the colored mailing envelope and seal.  
Read, sign, and date the affidavit on the colored envelope.  
Please note that power of attorney is not recognized. If you are unable to sign the colored mailing envelope, two (2) people must witness your mark on the envelope. The witnesses must also write "Witnessed by," then sign their names on the mailing envelope. The ballot envelope must be postmarked by the date of the election to be valid.

**INITIATIVE MEASURE 900**  
Initiative Measure No. 900 concerns performance audits of governmental entities. This measure would direct the State Auditor to conduct performance audits of state and local governments, and dedicate 0.16% of the state's portion of sales and use tax collections to fund these audits.
