INITIATIVE MEASURE NO. 920

PROPOSED TO THE PEOPLE BY THE LEGISLATURE
AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 4223

The legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment on increasing an exemption from the personal property tax.

This amendment would authorize the legislature to increase the personal property tax exemption for taxable personal property owned by each "head of a family" from three thousand (\$3,000) to fifteen thousand (\$15,000) dollars.

Emergency Medical Services Levy (Skagit County Medic 1)

The Board of Skagit County Commissioners adopted Resolution R20060286 concerning a tax levy to support emergency medical services. This ballot proposition, if approved, would authorize the County to levy additional regular property tax in the sum of \$0.25 or less per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for collection in 2007 and for five consecutive years thereafter, for emergency medical services for the citizens of Skagit County, including contracted paramedic ambulance services (Skagit County Medic 1), all as provided in Resolution R20060286.

FIDALGO POOL & FITNESS CENTER DISTRICT MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION LEVY
The Board of Directors of the Fidalgo Pool & Fitness Center District adopted Resolution No. 268 concerning a proposition to levy excess taxes to finance the District's maintenance and operation expenses. This proposition, if approved, would replace an expiring levy, and would authorize annual increases in the District's levy for three consecutive years for this purpose. Shall Fidalgo Pool & Fitness Center District continue to be funded for the next three years (2007-2009) by a tax of up to \$0.97 per \$1,000 assessed valuation (for example \$100,000 assessed property value equals \$9.70 per year) to provide \$319,112 in 2007, with additional increases, if deemed necessary, that will not exceed 1% each year, to pay part of maintenance and operational expenses, with taxes to be collected in 2007-2009.
