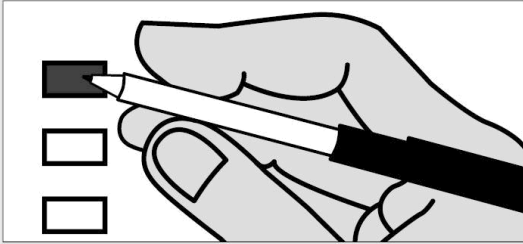

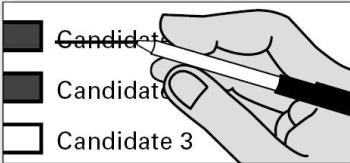
**Making selections**
