



Conway Consolidated School District No. 317**Proposition No. 1****General Obligation Bonds - \$9,030,000**

The Board of Directors of Conway Consolidated School District No. 317 adopted Resolution No. 9-2012 concerning this proposition for bonds. This proposition would authorize the District to undertake major renovations and upgrades to its primary, intermediate and middle school buildings, including life-safety improvements, to issue \$9,030,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 25 years, and to levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as provided in Resolution No. 9-2012.

La Conner School District No. 311**Proposition No. 1****General Obligation Bonds - \$20,693,000**

The Board of Directors of La Conner School District No. 311 adopted Resolution No. CPF2012-01 concerning this proposition for bonds. This proposition would authorize the District to undertake major renovations and upgrades to its elementary, middle school and high school buildings, including energy conservation and life-safety improvements, to issue \$20,693,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 20 years, and to levy excess property taxes annually replacing the existing bond levy expiring in 2014 to repay the bonds, as provided in Resolution No. CPF2012-01.

Skagit County Fire Protection District No. 9**Proposition No. 1****General Obligation Bonds - \$3,000,000**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Skagit County Fire Protection District No. 9 adopted Resolution No. 12-183 concerning this proposition for bonds. This proposition would authorize the District to plan and construct a new fire station facility, to issue \$3,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of twenty years, and to collect excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as provided in Resolution No. 12-183.
