Proposition No. 1  
Property Tax Levy for Fire Protection and  
Emergency Medical Services

The Board of Skagit County Fire Protection District No. 8 adopted Resolution No. 3-2024 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations. This proposition would finance fire protection and emergency medical services by establishing the District's regular property tax levy in 2024 at an amount not to exceed \$1.25 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation and authorize setting the limit factor at 103% for each of the following five years. The maximum allowable levy in the final year shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by Chapter 84.55 RCW.

Skagit County Fire Protection District No. 10 and Skagit County Fire Protection District No. 19 have adopted a Joint Resolution approving the Skagit County Regional Fire Authority Plan ("Plan") concerning the creation of a Regional Fire Authority.

This proposition would approve the Plan and create the Skagit County Regional Fire Authority, effective September 30, 2024 to provide fire protection and emergency medical services funded by a property tax not to exceed \$.90 per thousand of assessed value to be levied in 2024 and collected in 2025 which levy shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations.

The Board of Skagit County Fire Protection District No. 14 adopted Resolution No. 2024-01 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.

Joint Proposition No. 1  
Fidalgo Metropolitan Recreation District

The Skagit County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. R20240026 and the City of Anacortes City Council adopted Resolution No. 3147, concerning a joint proposition to form a metropolitan park district. If approved, this proposition would create the Fidalgo Metropolitan Recreation District with the powers provided in chapter 35.61 RCW. The District would be governed by a five-member board of commissioners to be elected at large, and its boundaries would be coterminous with the Anacortes School District.
