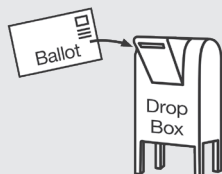

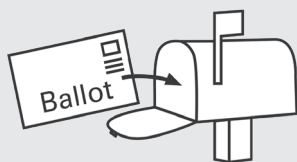
Proposition No. 1 - Replacement Educational Programs and Operations Levy

## Proposition No. 1

### Replacement Educational Programs and Operations Levy

The Board of Directors of La Conner School District adopted Resolution No. GF 25-02 concerning a replacement levy for education. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, to replace an expiring levy to support the District's educational programs and operations which are not funded or not fully funded by the State:

Collection Years	Approximate Rate/\$1,000 Assessed Value	Levy Amount
2026	\$1.11	\$1,125,000
2027	\$1.11	\$1,165,000
2028	\$1.11	\$1,205,000
2029	\$1.11	\$1,250,000

### Explanatory Statement

Written by La Conner School District No. 311

Passage of Proposition No. 1 would allow the levy of \$1,125,000 in property taxes within La Conner School District No. 311 for collection in 2026, the levy of \$1,165,000 for collection in 2027, the levy of \$1,205,000 for collection in 2028 and the levy of \$1,250,000 for collection in 2029, to replace an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, to support the District's educational programs, services and operations. In accordance with Resolution No. GF 25-02 approving this proposition, these taxes would be collected over four years and deposited in the District's General Fund to pay part of the educational programs, services and operations of the District, including employee costs (such as salaries), instructional materials, technology, athletics, buildings and transportation, maintenance of facilities and other non capital expenses of operating the District's schools, not funded or fully funded by the State.

If authorized by the voters, and based on projected assessed valuation, estimated levy rates per \$1,000 of assessed value would be \$1.11 (2026 collection); \$1.11 (2027 collection); \$1.11 (2028 collection); and \$1.11 (2029 collection). The exact levy rate shall be adjusted based upon the actual assessed value of the property within the District at the time of the levy.

Exemptions from taxes may be available to certain homeowners. To determine if you qualify, call the Skagit County Assessor at 360-416-1780.
