## CONCRETE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 11, SKAGIT AND WHATCOM COUNTIES, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 1533 REPLACEMENT OF EXPIRING LEVY FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the money in and to be paid into the General Fund of Concrete School District No. 11, Skagit and Whatcom Counties, Washington (the "District"), during the 2026-2027, 2027-2028, 2028-2029, 2029-2030, and 2030-2031 school years will be insufficient to enable the District to provide for educational programs and operations and to properly meet the educational needs of students attending District schools; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for such educational programs and operations and such educational needs, it is deemed necessary that additional taxes in the amounts set forth herein be levied for the District's General Fund upon all of the taxable property within the District in excess of the maximum annual tax levy permitted by law without a vote of electors; and

WHEREAS, the existing authority for the imposition of local tax levies and use of local revenues (including the proceeds of tax levies) has been modified most recently by Chapter 404, Laws of 2025 (69th Legislature, Regular Session) and may be modified in the future by the State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution and laws of the State of Washington require that the question of whether or not such taxes may be levied must be submitted to the qualified electors of the District for their ratification or rejection;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF CONCRETE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 11, SKAGIT AND WHATCOM COUNTIES, WASHINGTON, as follows:

- 1. <u>Declaration of Need</u>. It is hereby found and declared that the welfare of the students and other residents of the District require the District to carry out the plans described herein.
- 2. <u>Levy of Taxes</u>. In order to provide funds for the educational programs and operations of the District as described in Section 3 below, the following taxes for the District's General Fund should be levied upon all of the taxable property within the District in excess of the maximum annual tax levy permitted by law to be levied for the District without a vote of the electors:

<sup>\*</sup>Approximate levy rate per \$1,000 of assessed valuation based on 100% of true and fair value.

The exact levy rate and the actual amounts to be collected shall be adjusted based upon the actual assessed value of the property within the District at the time of the levy and the legal limit on the levy rate and levy amount applicable at the time of the levy.

The Assessors of Skagit and Whatcom Counties are authorized and directed, without further Board action, to reduce the General Fund excess property tax levy amount to be extended upon the tax rolls and collected in calendar years 2027, 2028, 2029, and 2030 to be consistent with the limitations imposed by RCW 84.52.0531.

The excess taxes identified above replace the expiring school program levies that were previously authorized by the voters of the District.

- 3. Voter Approval and Use of Funds. Upon approval by the District's voters of Ballot Proposition No. 1 described in Section 4 below, the District may use the proceeds of the levies to pay such part of the general expenses of the educational programs and operations of the District as may be authorized or allowed by law for the use of such levy funds including those identified below, and to repay warrants or other lawful indebtedness incurred to defray such operation and maintenance expenses. The levy proceeds together with the state matching funds that are received as a result of voter approval of Ballot Proposition No. 1, shall be expended to fund programs such as middle and high school athletic/activity programs, afterschool enrichment activities, afterschool tutoring programs, preschool programs, music program support, summer school programs, special-education programs not funded through basic education, enrichment programs, and to provide transportation outside of the basic school day, to assist in reducing class size, to provide supervision/support services, and for District maintenance and operations outside of basic education funding.
- 4. Request for Special Election. The Skagit County Auditor, as ex officio supervisor of elections in said county, is hereby requested to call and conduct a special election to be held within the District on February 10, 2026 and to submit to the qualified electors of the District the proposition set forth below. The Secretary of the Board of Directors is hereby authorized and directed to certify the proposition in the following form:

## "PROPOSITION NO. 1 CONCRETE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 11 REPLACEMENT OF EXPIRING LEVY FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS

The Board of Directors of Concrete School District No. 11 adopted Resolution No. 1533 concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operations expenses. This proposition would replace the expiring levy by authorizing the following excess taxes upon all taxable property in the District as an enrichment levy for the District's General Fund to support educational programs and operations not funded by the State:
