

EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, CEMETERY DISTRICT NO. 2, SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON, a municipal corporation, grant and convey to PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON, a Municipal Corporation, its successors or assigns, the right to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove at any time a pipe or pipes, line or lines for the transportation of water, and if necessary to erect, maintain, operate and remove said lines, with right of ingress and egress to and from the same, on, over and through a tract of land described as follows:

The east 330 feet of the north half of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 5, township 34 north, range 2 east, W.M., EXCEPT the east 30 feet for road, and ALSO EXCEPT that portion deeded to the State of Washington, by deed dated January 16, 1960 and filed under auditor's file No. 590458.

The location of easement over the above described tract of land is more particularly described as follows:

The east 20.0 feet of the above described tract of land.

The Grantee herein, and their successors and assigns shall have the right to do whatever may be requisite for the enjoyment of the rights herein granted, including the right of clearing said right of way for purpose of ingress and egress to and from said property, for the purpose of laying, maintaining, repairing, renewing, changing the size of, and restoring of said pipelines or the removal of the same when desired by the Grantee, their successors or assigns.

The Grantee is to be responsible, as provided by law, for any loss or damage resulting to the Grantor through its negligence, or intentional acts, in the construction, maintenance and operation of said pipe lines over and across the property of said Grantor.

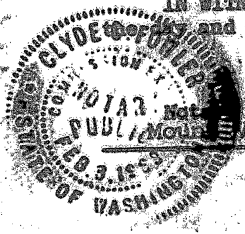
