### **RESOLUTION NO. 1832-98**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ORDERING THE ACQUISITION. CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE LAKE SAMISH ROAD AREA OF THE DISTRICT, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 1825-98; ESTABLISHING LOCAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 24 AND ORDERING THE CARRYING OUT OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS: PROVIDING THAT PART OF THE PAYMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS BE MADE BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS UPON THE PROPERTY IN THE LOCAL UTILITY DISTRICT, PAYABLE BY THE MODE OF "PAYMENT BY BONDS"; CREATING A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT FUND; AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF LOCAL UTILITY DISTRICT WARRANTS REDEEMABLE IN CASH OR OTHER SHORT-TERM FINANCING AND LOCAL UTILITY DISTRICT OR REVENUE BONDS.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1825-98 adopted September 22, 1998, the Commission of Public Utility District No. 1 of Skagit County, Washington (the "District"), declared its intention to order the improvement of the properties within the Lake Samish Road area of the District described in Exhibit A of that Resolution, by the acquisition, construction and installation of water system improvements to that area, in accordance with plans on file in the District's office and to create a local utility district to assess part of the cost and expense of carrying out those improvements against the properties specially benefited thereby, and fixed October 14, 1998, at 7:00 p.m., local time, at the District's Aqua Room located at 1415 Freeway Drive, Mount Vernon, Washington, as the time and place for hearing all matters relating to the proposed improvements and all objections thereto and for determining the method of payment for the improvements; and

WHEREAS, the District's Planning Engineer and staff caused an estimate to be made of the cost and expense of the proposed improvements and certified that estimate to the Commission, together with all papers and information in its possession touching the proposed improvements, a description of the boundaries of the proposed local utility district and a statement of what portion of the cost and expense of the improvements should be borne by the property within the proposed district; and

WHEREAS, that estimate is accompanied by a diagram of the proposed improvements showing thereon the lots, tracts, parcels of land, and other property which will be specially benefited by the proposed improvements and the estimated cost and expense thereof to be borne by each lot, tract and parcel of land or other property; and

WHEREAS, due notice of the above hearing was given in the manner provided by law, and the hearing was held by the Commission on the date and at the time above mentioned, and all persons appearing at such hearing and wishing to be heard were heard; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, all objections to the proposed improvements have been duly considered, the Commission is of the opinion that the boundaries should be amended by the Commission to remove properties abutting Shaw Road and all other objections to the formation should be overruled; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined it to be in the best interests of the District that the improvements as hereinafter described be carried out, that the proposed improvements are financially and economically feasible and that a local utility district be created in connection therewith:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of Public Utility District No. 1 of Skagit County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The Commission being fully advised and after due consideration overrules all objections, except those of owners of property along Shaw Road within the proposed boundaries of LUD No. 24, and orders the improvement of the properties in the Lake Samish Road area of the District described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, by acquiring, constructing and installing the improvements as more particularly described and set forth in Exhibit B in accordance with plans on file in the District's office (the "Improvements").

All of the foregoing shall be in accordance with the plans and specifications therefore prepared by the District's Engineering Manager and consulting engineers, and

may be modified by the Commission as long as such modification does not affect the purpose of the Improvements.

Section 2. The Commission finds and determines that the Improvements are financially and economically feasible.

Section 3. There is created and established a local utility district to be called Local Utility District No. 24 of the District ("LUD No. 24"), the boundaries or territorial extent thereof being more particularly described in Exhibit A.

Section 4. The total estimated cost and expense of the Improvements is declared to be \$722,000, of which it is anticipated that approximately \$346,400 will be paid by a grant from an agency of the United States Department of Agriculture. All of the remaining cost and expense shall be borne by and assessed against the property specially benefited by the Improvements included in LUD No. 24 which embraces as nearly as practicable all property benefited by the Improvements. The Improvements will be augmented by additional improvements as more particularly described and set forth in Exhibit B in accordance with plans on file in the District's office (the "Upsizing/Reservoir Work"). The total estimated cost and expense of the Upsizing/Reservoir Work is declared to be \$271,600. All of the cost and expense of the Upsizing/Reservoir Work shall be borne by the District, its contractual partners and the Alger LUD No. 22 and none of the cost and expense of the Upsizing/Reservoir Work shall be borne by or assessed against the property specially benefited by the Improvements in LUD No. 24.

Section 5. In accordance with the provisions of RCW 35.44.047, the District may use any method or combination of methods to compute assessments which may be deemed to fairly reflect the special benefits to the properties being assessed. Actual assessments may vary from estimated assessments as long as they do not exceed a figure equal to the increased true and fair value the Improvements added to the property.

Section 6. No property, any portion of which is inside or outside of LUD No. 24, may connect to those improvements constructed or made a part of such LUD unless either that property shall have been subject to the special assessments on the assessment roll for that LUD or the owners of that property shall have paid prior to such connection a charge in lieu of assessment which shall be at least the equivalent of those assessments which would have been applied to that property had it been included within LUD No. 24. This provision does not apply to connections to distribution line extensions connected to distribution lines installed by LUD No. 24.

Local improvement warrants may be issued in payment of the cost and expense of the Improvements herein ordered to be assessed, such warrants to be paid out of the Local Improvement Fund, District No. 24, hereinafter created and referred to as the Local Improvement Fund, and, until the bonds referred to in this section are issued and delivered to the purchaser thereof, to bear interest from the date thereof at a rate to be established hereafter by the Auditor of the District, as issuing officer, and to be redeemed in cash and/or by local utility district or revenue bonds herein authorized to be issued, such interest-bearing warrants to be hereafter referred to as "revenue warrants." In the alternative, the District hereafter may provide by resolution for the issuance of other shortterm obligations pursuant to Chapter 39.50 RCW. The Commission declares that to the extent, if any, the District prior to the date bonds or other short-term obligations are issued to finance the Improvements shall make capital expenditures for the Improvements from funds that are not (and are not reasonably expected to be) reserved, allocated on a long-term basis or otherwise set aside by the District under its existing and reasonably foreseeable budgetary and financial circumstances to finance the Improvements; those capital expenditure are intended to be reimbursed out of proceeds of the bonds or other short-term obligations issued in an amount not to exceed the principal amount provided by this resolution.

The District is authorized to issue local utility bonds or revenue bonds in payment of the cost and expense of the Improvements, to the payment of which bonds the assessments levied and collected in LUD No. 24 would be pledged. The entire principal and interest of such assessments shall be paid into such fund as the Commission shall hereafter direct and shall be used for the sole purpose of paying revenue warrants, other short-term obligations and/or bonds to be issued in payment of the costs and expense of the Improvements. The exact form, amount, date, interest rate and denominations of such bonds hereafter shall be fixed by resolution of the Commission. Such bonds shall be sold in such manner as the Commission hereafter shall determine.

Section 8. In all cases where the work necessary to be done in connection with the making of the Improvements is carried out pursuant to contract upon competitive bids and the District shall have and reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 2. The Local Improvement Fund, District No. 24, is created and established in the office of the District Treasurer. The proceeds from the sale of revenue warrants or other short-term obligations drawn against the fund which may be issued and sold by the District and the collections of special assessments, interest and penalties thereon shall be deposited in the Local Improvement Fund. Cash warrants to the contractor or contractors in payment for the work to be done by them in connection with the Improvements and cash warrants in payment for all other items of expense in connection with the Improvements may be issued against the Local Improvement Fund.

Section 10. Within fifteen (15) days of the adoption of this resolution there shall be filed with the District Treasurer the title of the Improvements and local utility district number, a copy of the diagram or print showing the boundaries of LUD No. 24 and the preliminary assessment roll or abstract of such roll showing thereon the lots, tracts and parcels of land that will be specially benefited thereby and the estimated cost and expense of such improvement to be borne by each lot, tract or parcel of land. The District Treasurer immediately shall post the proposed assessment roll upon his index of local improvement assessments against the properties affected by the local improvement.

# **IMPROVEMENTS**

The purpose of this Local Utility District is to construct and install a new water system due to the poor quality and inadequate supply of local groundwater.

The Improvements will involve the construction and installation of the following:

- A. Approximately 17,000 feet of 12-, 8-, 6- and 4-inch waterline.
- B. A pump station to serve the Cantershire area within the northwest portion of the LUD boundary.
- C. Approximately fifty-six (56) water services, four (4) combination air/vacuum relief assemblies, approximately five (5) fire hydrant assemblies, three (3) flushing assemblies, miscellaneous materials, and other appurtenances.

**UPSIZING/RESERVOIR WORK** 

The purpose of this Upsizing/Reservoir Work is to improve the capacity of the proposed Improvements indicated above to serve domestic and fire flow capacity from the Alger water system to properties located to north, east and south of the local utility district. Locating the water storage reservoir within the Lake Samish Road Local Utility District is cost-effective and provides system reliability and fire flow capacity required for both the Alger and Lake Samish Road areas.

The Upsizing/Reservoir Work will include the construction and installation of the following:

- A. Increase the waterline size of all remaining Improvements along Lake Samish Road to 12-inch from the start of the Improvements near Colony Road to the north end of those Improvements near the Skagit-Whatcom County line.
- B. A water storage reservoir and associated waterline and appurtenances located in the north half of the south half of Section 1 lying west of Lake Samish Road.


