To protect the security of this Deed of Trust, Grantor convents and agrees:

To keep the property in good condition and repair; to permit no waste thereof; to complete any building, structure or improvement being built or about to be built thereon; to restore promptly any building structure or improvement thereon which may be damaged or destroyed; and to comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting the property.

- 2. To pay before delinquent all lawful taxes and assessments upon the property; to keep the property free and cleer of all other charges, liens or encumbrances impairing the security of this Deed of Trust.
- 3. To keep all buildings now or hereafter erected on the property described herein continuously insured against loss by fire or other hazerds in an amount not then the fold debt secured by the Deed of Trust. All policies shall be held by the Beneficiary, and be in such companies as the Beneficiary may approve and have loss payable first to the Baneficiary, as its interest may appear, and then to the Grantor. IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:

- 1. In the event any portion of the property is taken or damaged in an embent domain proceeding, the entire amount of the event or such portion as may be necessary to fully satisfy the obligation accured hereby, shall be paid to Beneficiary to be applied to said obligation.
- 2. By accepting payment of any sum socured hereby after its due date, Beneficiary does not waive its right to require prompt psyment when due of all other so secured or to declare default logifully is to so pay.
- 3. The Trustee shall reconvey all or any part of the property covered by this Deed of Trust to the person entitled thereto, an written request of the Grantor and the Beneficiary, or upon satisfaction of the obligation secured and written request for reconveyance made by the Beneficiary or the person entitled thereto.
- 4. If all or any part of the property or an interest therein is sold or transferred by Granlor without the Beneficiary's prior written consent, excluding a) the creation of a lien or encumbrance subordinale to the Deed of Trust; b) the creation of a purchase money security interest on household appliances; c) a transfer by devise, decent, or by operation of law upon the death of a joint tenant, or d) the grant of any leasehold interest of three years or less not containing an option to purchase, Beneficiary may, at Beneficiary's option, declare all of the sums secured by this Deed of Trust to be immediately due and payable.
- 5. Upon default by Grantor in the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in the performance of any agreement contained herein, all sums secured hereby shall immediately become due and payable at the option of the Beneficiary. In such event and upon written request of Beneficiary, Trustee shall sell the trust property in accordance with the Deed of Trust Act of the State of Washington, at public auction to the highest bidder. Any person except Trustee may bid at Trustee's sale. Trustee shall apply the proceeds of the sale as follows: (1) to the expenses of the sale, including a reasonable Trustee's fee and attorney's fee; (2) to the obligation secured by the Deed of Trust, (3) the surplus, if any, shall be distributed to the persons entitled thereto.
- 6. Trustee shall deliver to the purchaser at the sale its deed, without warranty, which shall convey to the purchaser the interest in the property which Grantor had or had the power to convey at the time of his execution of this Deed of Trust, and such as he may have acquired thereafter. Trustee's deed shall recite the facts showing that the sale was conducted in compliance with all the requirements of law and of this Deed of Trust, which recital shall be prima facile evidence of such conclusive evidence thereof in favor of bona fide purchaser and
- 7. The power of sale conferred by this Deed of Trust and by the Deed of Trust Act of the State of Washington is not an exclusive remedy. Beneficiary may cause this Deed of Trust to be foreclosed as a mortgage.
- 8. In the event of the death, incapacity, disability or resignation of the Trustee, Beneficiary may appoint in writing a successor trustee, and upon the recording or such appointment in the mortgage records of the county in which the Deed of Trust is recorded, the successor trustee shall be vested with all powers of the original trustee. The trustee is not obligated to notify any party hereto of pending safe under any other Deed of Trust or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor, Trustee or Beneficiary shall be a party unless such action or proceeding is brought by the Trustee.
- 9. This Deed of Trust applies to, insures to the benefit of, and is binding not only on the parties hereto, but on their heirs, devisees, legalees, administrators, executors and assigns. The term Beneficiary shall mean the holder and owner of the note secured hereby whether or not named as Beneficiary herein.
