That portion of the Southeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 5, Township 36 North, Range 4 East, W.M., lying Easterly of the Easterly line of the revised 60 foot wide Alger-Cain Lake Road as said road was conveyed to Skagit County for road purposes by deed dated May 18, 1953 and recorded June 25, 1953 under Auditor's File No. 489882, records of Skagit County, Washington.

EXCEPT that portion of the South 30 feet of said Southeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ lying between the boundaries of the Old Alger-Cain Lake Road and the C.C.C. Road, as said C.C.C. Road existed on July 9, 1945, and as reserved by deed recorded September 12, 1945 under Auditor's File No. 383122, records of Skagit County, Washington.
