Affidavit of Publication In Support of Notice of Intent to File Claim Abandonment & Extinguishment of Mineral Interests Pursuant to RCW 78.22.050

The undersigned, being first duly sworn on oath states the following:

- 1. I am the Tribal Chairman of the Samish Indian Nation (Tribe), a federally recognized Indian tribe located in Anacortes, Washington. I am authorized under the laws of the Tribe to make this statement on behalf of the Tribe. I make this statement in support of the Tribe's Notice of Intent to File Claim of Abandonment & Extinguishment of Mineral Interests on property owned by the Samish Nation.
- 2. The lands affected by the mineral interests are located on a portion of the Tribe's Fidalgo Bay RV Resort, 4701 Fidalgo Bay Road, NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 (Government Lots 1 & 2), Sec. 18, TWN 32 N, RGE 4E, N.M., City of Anacortes, Skagit County, Washington; portions of tax lots P33271, P33272, and P33269.
- 3. The holder of the mineral interest identified by the Skagit County Auditor's record is E.G. Van Valkenburg. The instrument creating the reservation of mineral rights was a deed recorded May 1, 1911, recorded in Skagit County Auditor's No. 84554 (Vol 85 of Deeds, page 296). According the county records, Mr. Van Valkenburg died on October 20, 1916.
- 4. The Tribe contacted the Skagit County Treasurer's office to obtain the name and address of the current mineral interest owner of these interests secured by Mr. Van Valkenburg. The County informed the Tribe that there is not a current owner of these mineral interests listed in the county property tax records.
- 5. The Tribe exercised due diligence in trying to ascertain the current owner of these mineral interests by undertaking substantial research in state and county land records. On or about December 12, 2007, the Tribe contacted the Washington Department of Natural Resources to determine if there were any records within their possession on the ownership of these interests. The Tribe was informed that the State Department of Natural Resources did not have any such records. In December 2007 and January 2008, the tribal staff researched the Skagit County Auditor's land records to determine if these interests were ever transferred. There is no record that these interests were transferred.

There is no record of a will being probated by Mr. Van Valkenburg in Skagit County. We have been unable to locate any heirs of Mr. Van Valkenburg. The Tribe has not been able to locate any evidence suggesting that these interests were ever transferred or devised by Mr. Van Valkenburg.

6. The Tribe caused notice of the intent to Notice of Intent to File Claim
Abandonment & Extinguishment of Mineral Interests in the Skagit Valley Herald for
three consecutive weeks beginning February 29, 2008 and finishing March 14, 2008 and
the Affidavit of Publication from the Skagit Valley Herald will be recorded
contemporaneously with my affidavit.
