- B. <u>Purposes</u>. This Subordination Agreement and Limited Lien Waiver is required by the United States in connection with its acquisition of an easement over the property described above to ensure that the easement area is maintained to promote wetland functions and values.
- C. <u>Duration of Easement and this Subordination Agreement and Limited Lien Waiver</u>.

 The easement and subordination and limited lien waiver shall continue in for the duration of the easement deed.

PART II - SUBORDINATION AGREEMENT AND LIMITED LIEN WAIVER

The Subordinating Party: (1) subordinates its interest in the property described herein to the easement of the United States for the same property which is conveyed to the United States in the easement; (2) acknowledges that the property which contains the easement area is burdened by the right of access granted to the United States in the easement and agrees that this right of access shall be superior to any rights of the Subordinating Party; (3) subordinates its interest in the property to the purposes of the easement and any easement practices adopted pursuant to such purposes; and (4) agrees that the United States may make payments in connection with the easement deed without regard to any lien or claim that the Subordinating

This Subordination Agreement and Limited Lien Waiver: (1) binds the Subordinating Party and its heirs, agents, assigns, and successors with respect to the interests that the Subordinating Party and such other persons have, or may have, in the property or against any person having an interest in the property; and (2) inures in favor of the United States and its agents, successors, or assigns of any kind.


