
**RECITALS:**

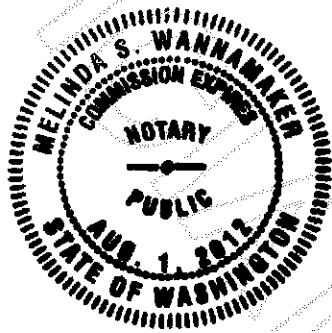


