That the said Grantors for valuable consider	ration do by these presents grant
unto the Grantee a perpetual right-of-way or easement for sewer mains with the	
necessary appurtenances through, over and across the following described property	
situated in Skagit County, Washington, more particularly described as follows:	
Studied in Skagit County, Washington, more particularly described as longwe.	

A 10 foot wide non-exclusive easement for sanitary sewer over, under and across that portion of the abandoned 100 foot wide railroad right of way commonly known as the Northern Pacific Railway and beginning at the

intersection of Line "RR" as described on Page 3 of 3 AF 200704110001 filed 4/11/2007 in the County of Skagit, State of Washington, and the Centerline of the Vacated Hancock Street as per "PLAT OF RESERVE ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF MONTBORNE IN SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON" recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 59, records of Skagit County, Washington.

Thence North 47°38'15" East along the Centerline of said Hancock Street for 10.3 feet to the true point of beginning, being the Centerline of the 10 foot wide non-exclusive easement for sanitary sewer;

Thence South 38°50'47" East, paralleling the Centerline of said Line "RR" for 156.4 feet, more or less, to the Southeasterly line of Lot 12, Block 4, of said "PLAT OF RESERVE ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF MONTBORNE IN SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON", and the extension of the Southeasterly line of said lot 12 as it extends South 47°38'15" West across that portion of the abandoned 100 foot railroad to a terminus at said Line "RR".

Situate in the County of Skagit, State of Washington.

That said Grantee shall have the right without prior institution of any suit or proceeding at law, at such times as may be necessary, to enter upon said property for the purpose of constructing, repairing, altering, or reconstructing said sewer main, or making any connections therewith, without incurring any legal obligation or liability therefor, provided that such constructing, repairing, altering, or reconstructing of said sewer main shall be accomplished in such a manner that the private improvements existing in this right-of-way shall not be disturbed or destroyed, or in the event they are disturbed or destroyed, they will be replaced in as good a condition as they were immediately before the property was entered upon by the Grantee.

The Grantors shall retain the right to use the surface of said easement, so long as said use does not interfere with the installation and maintenance of the sewer main and so long as no permanent buildings or structures are erected on said easement.

This easement shall be a covenant running with the land and shall be binding on the successors, heirs, and assigns of both parties hereto.
