NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the undersigned Trustee will on September 5, 2014, at the hour of 10:00 a.m. on the first floor of the Skagit County Courthouse, 205 Kincaid St., Mount Vernon, Skagit County, Washington, sell at public auction to the highest and best bidder, payable at the time of sale, the following described real property, situated in Skagit County, Washington, to wit:

commonly known as 225 Chenoweth Street, Mount Vernon, WA 98273, which is subject to that certain Deed of Trust dated May 14, 2008, recorded under Auditor's File No. 200805210095, records of Skagit County, Washington, from State Street Retail Center, LLC, a Washington limited liability company, to Guardian Northwest Title & Escrow, as Trustee, to secure an obligation in favor of the Business Bank, as Beneficiary.

2. No action commenced by the Beneficiary of the Deed of Trust or the Beneficiary's successor is now pending to seek satisfaction of the obligation in any Court by reason of the Borrower's or Grantor's default on the obligation secured by the Deed of Trust.

3. The defaults for which this foreclosure is made are as follows:

- a. Non-monetary defaults:
Failure to pay 2013 and first half 2014 real property taxes on the subject property.
- b. Failure to pay when due the following amounts which are now in arrears:
Principal balloon payment of \$22,227.67, which was due in full on October 31, 2013.

Total amount in arrears: \$22,227.67

4. The principal sum owing on the obligation secured by the Deed of Trust is \$366,265.13, together with interest as provided in the note or other instrument secured from May 14, 2008, and such other costs and fees as are due under the note or other instrument secured, and as are provided by statute.

5. The above described real property will be sold to satisfy the expense of sale and obligation secured by the Deed of Trust as provided by statute. The sale will be made without warranty, express or implied, regarding title, possession, or encumbrances on September 5, 2014. The defaults referred to in Paragraph 3 must be cured by August 25, 2014 [11 days before the sale date] to cause a discontinuance of the sale. The sale will be discontinued and terminated if, at any time on or before August 25, 2014 [11 days before the sale date], the defaults as set forth in



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paragraph III are cured and the Trustee's fees and costs are paid. The sale may be terminated any time after August 25, 2014 [11 days before the sale date], and before the sale by the Borrower or Grantor, any Guarantor, or the holder of any recorded Junior lien or encumbrance paying the entire principal and interest secured by the Deed of Trust, plus costs, fees, and advances, if any, made pursuant to the terms of the obligation and/or Deed of Trust, and curing all other defaults.

7. The Trustee whose name and address are set forth below will provide in writing to anyone requesting it, a statement of all costs and fees due at any time prior to the sale.
8. The effect of the sale will be to deprive the Grantor and all those who hold by, through or under the Grantor of all their interest in the above-described property.
9. Anyone having any objection to the sale on any grounds whatsoever will be afforded an opportunity to be heard as to those objections if they bring a lawsuit to restrain the sale pursuant to RCW 61.24.130. Failure to bring such a lawsuit may result in a waiver of any proper grounds for invalidating the Trustee's sale.

NOTICE TO OCCUPANTS OR TENANTS

10. The purchaser at the Trustee's Sale is entitled to possession of the property on the 20th day following the sale, as against the Grantor under the Deed of Trust (the owner) and anyone having an interest junior to the Deed of Trust, including occupants who are not tenants. After the 20th day following the sale, the purchaser has the right to evict occupants who are not tenants by summary proceedings under Chapter 59.12 RCW. For tenant-occupied property, the purchaser shall provide a tenant with written notice in accordance with RCW 61.24.060.
11. The Trustee makes no representations or warranties concerning what interest in the real property described above is being sold. The Deed of Trust lien foreclosed may not be a first lien position or there may be other prior encumbrances of title. The Trustee is not required to provide title information concerning this property. Any person interested in this foreclosure is encouraged to make his or her own investigation concerning the ownership of the property and the position on title of the Deed of Trust being foreclosed. Any person interested in the foreclosure is also encouraged to consult an attorney, as the Trustee will not provide legal advice concerning the foreclosure. The Trustee does not provide information concerning the location of the debtors nor concerning the condition of the property. No representation or warranties are made concerning the physical condition of the property or whether there are any environmental or hazardous waste






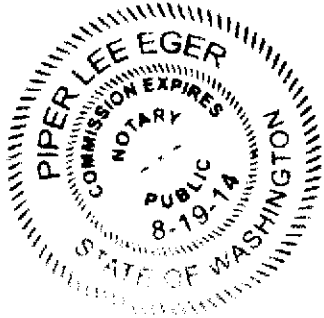
