LEGAL DESCRIPTION. The real property that is the subject of this Revocable Transfer on Death Deed is situated in the County of Skagit, State of Washington, and it is legally described as follow:

Lot 2, Skagit County Short Plat No. 92-003 (Being a Replat of Lot 2, Short Plat No. 91-31), approved April 8, 1992, recorded April 8, 1992, in Volume 10 of Short Plats, Page 73, under Auditor's File No. 9204080022, Records of Skagit County, Washington and being a portion of the Northwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 35 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian. Situated in Skagit County, Washington. Parcel B: a Non-exclusive easement for ingress, egress and utilities, as created in instrument recorded under Auditor's File Nos. 8902210090 and 8910230016, records of Skagit County, Washington; and also that certain non-exclusive easement 20 foot wide driveway easement over and across a portion of Lot 3 of said Short Plat No. 91-31 as reserved in document recorded under Auditor's File No. 9112230046, records of Skagit County, Washington, and corrected and re-recorded under Auditor's File No. 9201270105, Records of Skagit County, Washington.

TRANSFER ON DEATH. The Grantor transfers all of the Grantor's interest in the described property, including without limitation any after acquired title of the Grantor, to the beneficiaries set forth above. Before the Grantor's death, the Grantor remains the right to revoke this deed.

REAL ESTATE EXCISE TAX EXEMPTION. Recording this Revocable Transfer on Death Deed is not a "sale" as defined in RCW 82.45.010(1) and is therefore not subject to real estate excise tax. The transfer that will occur under this Revocable Transfer on Death Deed at the time of the Grantor's death is exempt from the Washington Real Estate Excise Tax under RCW 82.45.010(3)(b) and WAC 458-61A-202(7).
