Land Use Designation: Aviation Related (AVR)

Summary of Proposal: Minor Utility Development proposal to extend several utilities in

anticipation of new hangar construction. Including the extension of approximately 1,127 lineal feet of new 8-inch ductile iron water pipeline for domestic service and fire protection.

Approximately 695 linear feet of new 8-inch sanitary sewer pipe to be installed. The Port may further extend the waterline

approximately 110 feet to clear an existing taxi way.

Additionally, fiber optic vaults and approximately 1,130 lineal feet of conduit will be included so the Port can provide fiber

optic service to all of the new hangar structures.
