as may appear upon entry of the Property, the reasonable costs of which may be pursued, recorded and foreclosed by Skagit County as a lien on the Property. Any unauthorized individuals on the Property may be removed from the Property by County law enforcement officers to the extent their presence interferes with the safe and orderly abatement of the nuisance consistent with this order.

3. This judgment shall apply both personally against the Defendants and any successor in interest, as well as in rem against the Property. To the extent that Defendant wishes to sell or otherwise transfer the Property during the pendency of this suit, Defendant shall disclose the existence of this suit to any potential buyer, and any purchase of the Property by a third party shall be subject to this action, this judgment, and any rights and duties it involves. Skagit County may record a notice of this judgment against the Property.
