The petitioner was not present at the March 11, 2025, hearing.

This property is described as an apartment building located at 520 North 1st Street, Mount Vernon, Skagit County, Washington. The appellant cites, the property was assessed during a height in the market without considering the improvements that is still needed for this older property.

The Assessor, represented by Deputy Assessor Andrew Corcoran, provided an oral testimony stating that he has been unable to get in touch with the petitioner since 2023. There have been no permits issued, and I have not been able to confirm the work that has been done to the building.

BOE members present were Rich Holtrop, Angie Bossarte, and Betta Spinelli.

The burden of proof is on the petitioner to provide clear, cogent, and convincing evidence to support the appeal. The petition was received without a signature, no change of value notice, and no indication of the owners estimate of value, all required items for a completed petition. In this case, the petitioner did not submit sufficient evidence to support a reduction. Therefore, the Board finds that the petitioner has failed to overcome the evidentiary standard necessary to overrule the assessor.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Board unanimously upholds the Assessor.
